1. Welcome by the Chairman, Sarah Sayers.
 - Apologies received from Jill Willison, John and Cheryl Dilley, Laura Brazier, Debra Davies, Germana Sallemi and Glen Meadows.
2. Minutes of Last AGM were approved as a true copy and signed by the Chairman.
3. Presentation of Junior Trophies were made to most improved mini and junior players by the Club's president Coral Richards.
 - Most Improved Mini Player: Miki Hayama
 - Most Improved Junior Player: Jointly awarded to Stanley Vowles and Kalina Pavlou
4. **Chairman's Report – Sarah Sayers**

A copy of the report is attached. The main points to note for the purposes of the minutes are:

 - Total memberships are lower than this time last year (2023 numbers are in brackets) but that doesn't reflect the individual member numbers who are not named within the Family or Annual Pass packages.
 - Single – 55 (60)
 - Family – 42 (30)
 - Annual Pass – 22 (48)
 - Honorary – 7
 - Coaching, subscription fees, maintenance plan, competitive and social play, community and charity work were also covered off in summary.
5. **Treasurer's Report – Prepared by Laura Brazier and read by Sarah Sayers**

Presentation of the fund. A copy of the report is attached. Key points to note for the minutes:

- Accounts have been audited and signed off as in good order in November 2024.
- Closing balance for November 2024 is up by £5,291 from previous year.
- Total 2024 income was £15,987 and total 2024 expenditure was £10,696
- LTA loan is at £13,000 out of original £25,000 to help fund floodlights.
- Membership subscription fees were down £1,285 but pay and play was up £427. The maintenance costs were again around £4.5K but despite the wet weather conditions the cost of moss treatment was lower during 2023 however, the cost of the integrated/electronic gate security system had a large outgoing of £900.
- In order to meet the 2029 court resurfacing costs of £55K the club needs to increase its Cash Balance by £6K per annum which it is currently just under by about £700 in both 2023 and 2024.

7. **Match Secretary's report – Joe Gold**

The final positions of some of the winning teams and tournaments were read out and applauded along with a statement from the captains. All the captains reports can be found in Appendix B.

8. **Welfare Officer – Sarah Vincent**

Sarah re-introduced herself to the room as the Welfare and Safeguarding officer and why and how to get in contact with her.

CHAIRMAN's REPORT 2023-2024

We have had another successful year and you will hear from some of the officers this evening in more detail. We have a good bank balance, a competitive spirit with additional teams in Oxfordshire and Newbury leagues and the courts and club house are in a good state of repair.

Membership

It is difficult to say exactly how many individual members we have as some are recorded as 1 family membership and some have each individual member recorded under family. However we have received the following memberships:

55	£85 single
42	£50 annual pass
22	£150 family
7	Honorary

This is a drop in each membership category since last year, 19, but pay and play has increased by c£500.

Thank you to **Glenn Meadows** for being membership secretary and managing the subs and most importantly, welcoming new members.

Club Sessions

We have a few throughout the week, Tuesday at 7pm – which is very well attended, Wednesday day time, Friday morning and Sunday 9.30am. You don't need a partner, these sessions are open to all and all are welcome.

Competitions

Joe Gold, as match secretary will give a full report. We have a good competitive spirit within the club competing in both the Oxfordshire and Newbury leagues in Mens, Ladies and Mixed with teams playing throughout the year. Due to the number of teams, we have a



range of abilities. If anyone is interested in competing, please see one of the captains. Thank you also to all the many captains of the teams. You will see an item on the agenda later where the Committee have put forward the new role of Men's and Ladies' Captains.

Juniors & Safeguarding

Sarah Vincent is our Safeguarding officer responsible for ensuring we look after our juniors and vulnerable adults. I remind you all, this is not a job just for the Safeguarding officer or the club committee, it is down to us all to ensure that we maintain high standards of behaviour and we protect our juniors so they have a safe environment in which to play.

Social

Martin Wrench and Rob Hughes have organised some club tournaments this year which have been fun. The newly introduced Handicap tournament was a welcome addition to our programme and made sure we concentrated on keeping score. Thanks to you both.

Maintenance

The courts are maintained by Martin Wrench assisted by Bradley Hammond on a paid basis and voluntarily by David McPhail and other members. Thank you to everyone involved.

Each year we allocate funds for moss/weed killing, general maintenance of the courts and club house. We have a 10 year plan for both resurfacing and repainting to keep our courts and grounds in good condition and need £6000 pa for our court sinking fund.

Subscriptions

The subscription levels are determined by the Club Committee and not at the AGM. We have done some benchmarking against local clubs and we still offer exceptional value. We do get some income from the pay and play who are not members and Laura Brazier, our new Treasurer will go into more detail.

Coaching

As a result of us getting a loan for our lighting from the LTA, since 2021 we have had a provision of coaching service contract with National Tennis Association (NTA). They carry out the coaching on our courts, run the programmes and in return give the club some monies.



Dean Cornish (level V coach) who is part of the NTA joined us as coach in 2023 and is imminently moving on to a new role in Staffordshire. We are pleased to welcome **Tollef Ellam** who joined us recently as our new club coach. We are discussing with the NTA about the coaching programmes on offer to our members and to promote tennis with the juniors.

This just leaves me with a few thank you's - to your committee: **Glen Meadows, Jen Gold, Joe Gold, Germana Sallemi, Rob Hughes, Laura Brazier, David McPhail, Sarah Vincent, Debra Davies.**

A special thanks to **David** for spending many hours at the club and doing maintenance and is our unsung hero, to **Glenn** for sorting out the floodlights and Joe for the court availability for matches and socials. Thank you to all the club members for ensuring we have a club to be proud of.
